SITUATION

The vines of the DEALU MARE (which in Romanian means "great hill slope") are the most famous and renowned vine growing area in Romania. It is 60 kilometers long on hillsides which starts from the southeast of the Carpathian Mountains, enjoying the sun from early morning and a good sunlight all day long. The soil is made of chalk and limestone.

PRODUCTION & ORGANIC CERTIFICATION

To produce this high-end wine, we have selected the wines made with grapes from our best parcels of vines, located on the terrace, in the village of Breaza. Yields are very low, the wines produced are particularly concentrated. Moreover, to have a great aromatic complexity, we have chosen to age them in new oak, like the best wines of Burgundy.

Our vines in Breaza are grown organically, meaning that we use no insecticide, herbicide, pesticide or any chemical fertilizer. This method of cultivation is certified by Ecocert approved by the EEC according to the European regulations.

TASTING & GASTRONOMY

Our Pinot Noir is a dry wine with complex aromas of blackberries, currants and vanilla. It is elegant, round and balanced with a perfect balance between the tannins and the acidity that are necessary for good conservation.

It goes well with roasted poultry, grilled pork or beef and soft or hard cheeses.

STORY

Pinot Noir is the grape used to produce the best Burgundy reds: Romanee Conti, Chambertin, Pommard or Nuits-Saint-Georges. The monks of Citeaux, who, over the centuries, did select the best plants of this grape variety, have made its worldwide reputation of excellence.
