SITUATION

The vines of the DEALU MARE (which in Romanian means "great hill slope") are the most famous and renowned vine growing area in Romania. It is 60 kilometers long on hillsides which starts from the southeast of the Carpathian Mountains, enjoying the sun from early morning and a good sunlight all day long. The soil is made of chalk and limestone.

PRODUCTION & CERTIFICATION BIO

Our estate includes a few hectares of Riesling which enable us to produce each year around 10 000 bottles. Our vines are grown organically i.e. without the use of insecticides, herbicides, pesticides or chemical fertilizer. This method of winegrowing is certified Organic by Ecocert under the amended EC Regulation 2092/9. In addition we follow the principles of the lunar-organic viticulture.

TASTING & GASTRONOMIE

On the hill slopes of the Dealu MARE, our Riesling, known as Italian Riesling, produces elegant and dry wines with subtle aromas of wild flowers.

Crai Nou Riesling is perfect with starters, sausages, cold cuts and all types of fish grilled or in sauce.

STORY

Three thousand years ago, Romania was already growing vines. The Romanian wines were famous all over Europe and when the Roman conquered Romania in the second century, the symbol on coins for the new province then called "Dacia Felix", was a woman with two children offering wheat and grapes.
